

## How to be an Outstanding SENCo: the Effectiveness and Impact of SEND Provision

The new Code of Practice, implemented from September 2014, has had a significant impact on provision and outcomes for schools, local authorities, young people and parents/carers. The changes have also impacted on the already extensive role of the SENCo, making the post increasingly strategic and key to a school's success as a whole.

Gareth Morewood, one of the leading SENCos in the UK, will lead this new one-day course on which participants will develop an understanding of the recent changes in SEND legislation and provision, whilst considering the implications for them as leaders in their own institutions. Participants will gain practical ideas for the effective deployment of staff and successful development of a whole-school approach to SEND by ensuring that all staff have the necessary understanding and knowledge to support their students. There will be a focus on measuring impact and understanding how to implement Education Health and Care Plans within the school setting, including the use of personal budgets and an overview of the law.

Participants will:

- be aware of the legislation and accountability with regard to the SENCo role and SEND provision
- gain enhanced insight into the ability to plan and implement changes
- support the understanding and measurement of impact
- learn from practical examples
